Please include the names, email addresses and phone numbers of all presenters in your proposal, a short description (1/2 page) of the workshop topic to be presented, and your target audience. **Include TASSSP Conference Workshop Proposal in the subject line of the email.** All rooms will be set up in lecture style, a computer, projector, sound, and wifi will be accessible. Microphones will not be provided.
